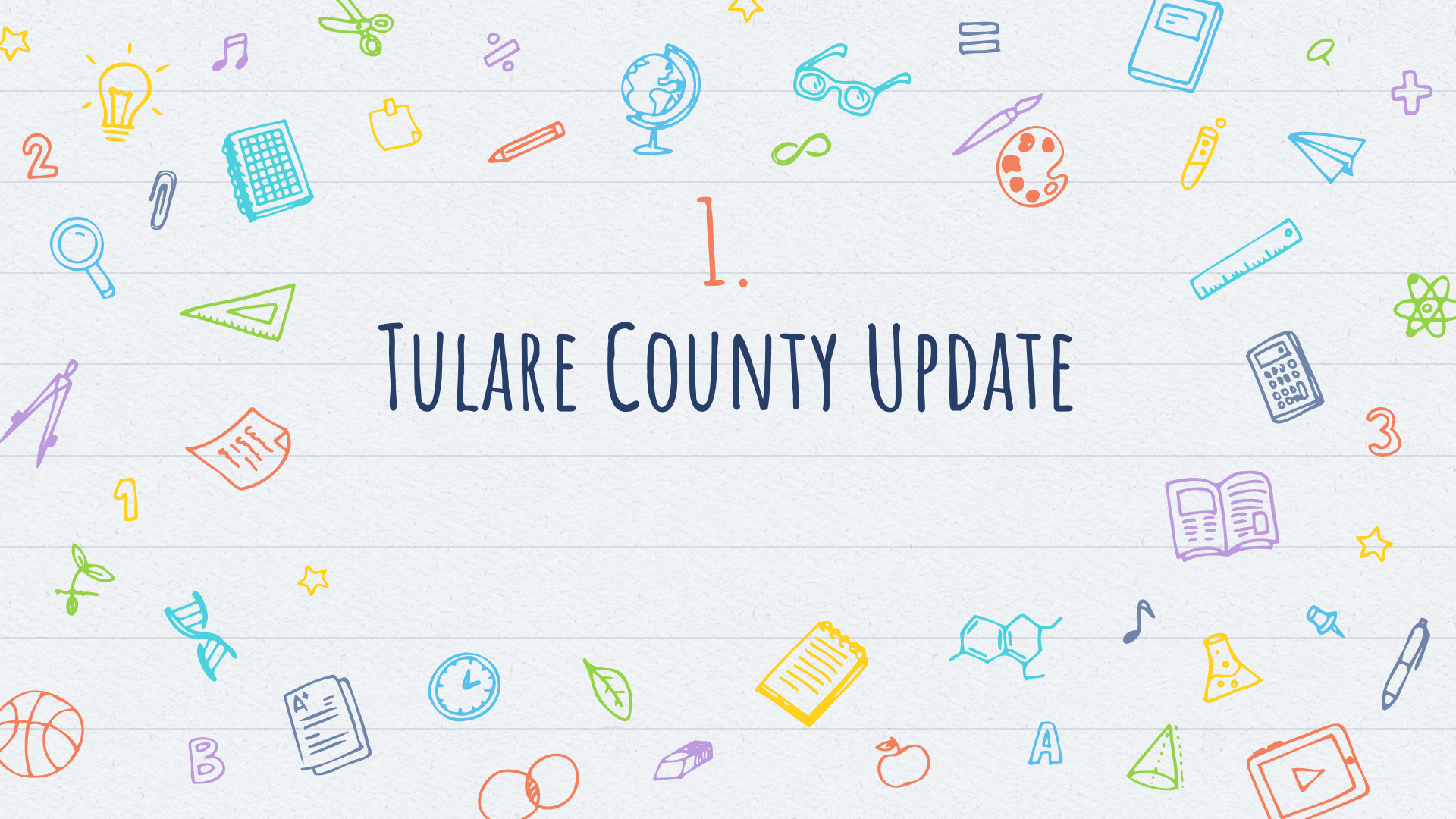

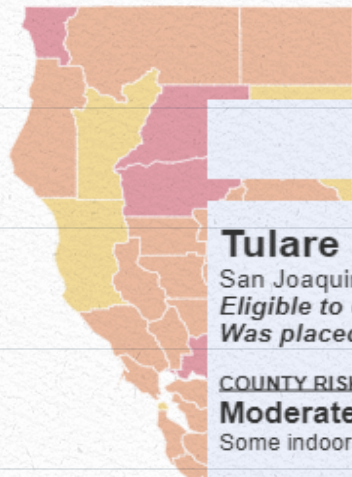

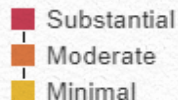

LET'S START NEXT YEAR STRONG!

Instruction will address any gaps in core academics, like math and language arts.

- Summer School is located at Mission Oak High School
- All incoming 8th grade students and current 9-11th grade students in the district are eligible to register for the summer program.
- A break timesnack and lunch will be available.
- In-classroom social distance of at least 4 feet.
- Start/end times will be from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm.
- Daily attendance is required. A single day's absence from summer school equates to over a week's absence from regular school.
- Transportation will be provided from Union, Western, Tipton and Pixley
